The Protected Areas Database of the U.S. (PAD-US) is a GIS data inventory of **federal, state, local government and nonprofit** land holdings. PAD-US is the official national inventory of these lands and is a **National Geospatial Data Asset**. Developed by U.S. Geological Survey, it is the best available representation of federal land ownership and management designations compiled from authoritative data through the **FGDC Federal Lands Working Group**.

This briefing will inform you about how PAD-US works and what you can do with it – and about the plans for the future of PAD-US. Our expert panel will respond to questions and suggestions.
